






## **Summer Camp**





# Financial Development Kim Morgan

## **Rental Pricing Change**

- From per person price to per room/cabin price
- Goals:
  - Promote more efficient use of lodging space
  - Simplify pricing
- Rates for different group types, like youth or family
- Discounts for Christian ministries, member congregations, longer stays, weekdays





## **Celebration: 2022 Matching Challenge**

- Fall 2022 Matching Challenge of \$50,000
- Goal: Raise another \$50k from community, for a total of \$100,000
- Funds for Vehicle Fund, FTCF camperships, and Income loss from fire
- Result: Raised additional \$80,000, surpassing the goal for a total of \$130,000



## 2023 True Cost of Camp Campaign

- True Cost of Camp: \$150,000 gap (500 campers)
- Goal: Raise \$130,000 with summer campaign (cover 433 campers)
- Challenge of \$65,000 from several families
- Goal to raise the additional \$65k from camp community
- Delegate challenge

# **Celebrate!**

- Memorandum of Agreement signed by SHPO, USFS, CPLOM
- Camp Perkins is a priority for the Sawtooth National Forest, not just the SNRA
- USFS Specialists coming this summer to review their areas and work towards a Categorical Exclusion
- Public Scoping will likely take place this summer (notice in the paper for public comment and interested parties to receive a letter)









