TIE DYE CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Did your camper tie dye anything this week? If so, we'd love to give you some tips to help care for it.

- 1. Allow dye to set for 24 hours. (Ideally, this step will be complete by the time you arrive at home.)
- 2. Remove rubber bands. Rinse the shirt in cold water to remove excess dye. Wearing rubber gloves is helpful.
- 3. Wash the shirt by itself in cold water.

After drying, your shirt is ready to wear! It should not bleed onto other clothing the next time it is washed but use care in what you wash it with just in case.









CHRISTIAN GROWTH AT CAMP

The following devotions are intended for use by families/guardians to reflect upon the scriptures and themes that your campers are learning about this week. We suggest that you use them as a family in the evening, so you can pray for your camper (and other campers!) for the next day. They also include great discussion points for the ride home on Friday. May God richly bless your time with Him this week!



SUNDAY: SOARING: FAITH RISING

In their fright the women bowed down with their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; he has risen!

Luke 24: 5-6

Big Picture – What would you do/say if you saw Jesus taken up into heaven through the clouds? Who is Jesus? What did He do? How does His Story end?

Focus Questions:

- -Describe why knowing that Jesus rose from the dead is important?
- -If Jesus rose from the dead what does that imply?



MONDAY: FALLEN: CRASH & BURN

The Lord turned and looked straight at Peter. Then Peter remembered the word the Lord had spoken to him: "Before the rooster crows today, you will disown me three times. Luke 22:61

Big Picture – How often do we fail God? Peter & Judas both fell & sinned against Jesus in very similar ways... both need a Savior... but the outcomes were drastically different... Why?

Focus Questions:

- -Who does Jesus claim to be in John 1?
- -In Luke 22, it describes both Judas' and Peter's betrayal... What do you think Jesus' reaction was to both of these situations? Was one worse than the other?



TUESDAY: GROUNDED

for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.

Romans 3:23-24

Big Picture – We cannot do "Faith" on our own. If we try to play a part the focus quickly moves from God to ourselves... much like the story of Peter walking on water with Jesus.

Focus Questions:

-Where does your faith come from? -What does God provide so that we are not alone in our Faith?







WEDNESDAY: FLYING SOLO

Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age.

Matthew 28:19-20

Big Picture – Ever since sin entered the world God has been fighting to bring us back together with Him. While He gives us our faith through His Word... God designed our faith to grow in community.

Focus Questions:

- -Why do you think that God designed the Church?
- -Where can you go to find a community of believers who will point you to the cross of Christ?

THURSDAY: ASCEND

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

Acts 1:8

Big Picture – God loves you so much that He not only sent a Savior... He sends a helper to start and sustain Faith. Just as Jesus restored Peter and forgave him for his betrayal (sin)... Jesus has restored us through his sacrifice and resurrection.

Focus Questions:

-How do you think the disciples and Peter felt as they watched Jesus ascend into the sky?
-What does God ask Peter to do after each time Peter responds to Jesus' question, "Do you love

me?"



FRIDAY: SOARING: FLYING HOME

After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight.

Acts 1:9

Big Picture – We did nothing to earn it, yet Jesus still loves & forgives us. He proved our forgiveness when he rose from the dead... What is next? We share His Faith with those we know & those we meet.

Focus Questions:

-How can we apply and share what we've learned at camp to our lives back at home?
